When Julie Would Have Nixon Quit

Julie Nixon Eisenhower, the President's younger daughter, believes that if her father was involved in Watergate and lied to the American people "he should resign," according to an interview published yesterday.

But Mr. Nixon is not guilty of any wrongdoing and would never "bug out" before the end of his term, she said in the interview published in the February edition of McCall's magazine.

Julie had said earlier that the President discussed with his family the possibility of his resigning from office.

"If he is involved in Watergate and has been lying to the American people, then, yes, he should resign, because then he would be guilty of a coverup," she told McCall's.

"But he said he was not involved."
