NYTimes State of the Union Talk Is Put Back to Jan. 30

UPI) — President Nixon will deliver his State of the Union message to Congress the night of Jan. 30, the White House announced today.

The speech had previously been planned for the afternoon of Jan. 29. Gerald L. Warren, the White House deputy press secretary, said that Mr. Nixon had put off the speech by one day to accommodate the Washington Press Club, which holds its annual Congressional dinner Jan. 29.

Mr. Warren said that the President was considering sending his annual Economic Report to Congress Feb. 1 and submitting his 1975 Federal budget Feb. 4.
