WARSAW, Va. Jan. 22 (AP)
The House of Representatives may vote to impeach President Nixon, but the Senate will not convict him, Rep. Thomas N. Downing (D. Va.), said Monday night.

night.

Downing, speaking to a group of Northern Neck County officials, said that if the House Judiciary Committee recommends removal of Mr. Nixon "it will probably be done in the House... but the Senate will never prevail in impeachment."

A House vote to impeach, Downing said, probably would bring about Mr. Nixon's resignation, however.
