WASHINGTON (UPI) — President Nixon views the forthcoming bicentennial of the American Revolution as a moment to 'look ahead' from the nation's present troubles, according to White House counsellor Ann Armstrong.

She told the National Press Club yesterday the celebration "should help Americans think in long-range terms...to not only look back 200 years but to look ahead 200 years."

Mrs. Armstrong, who has been designated to oversee the 200th anniversary of the birth of the nation beginning next year, did not mention Nixon's Watergate problems specifically. But she predicted he would use the occasion to redirect the country's motivation toward future progress.
