Who Feel Nixon
Should Resign

The weekly business and financial magazine Dun's Review said yesterday that a majority of 300 corporate chief executives it polled feels President Nixon should resign.

The company heads were overwhelmingly opposed to impeachment, however, said Dun's, which did not give the size of the majority.

The businessmen polled were not identified by name or company, but the magazine described them as "300 of the nation's most influential executives."
