Poll Says Nixon
SFChronicle
Candor on Taxes
Made It Worse

New York

Pollster Louis Harris says a survey indicates President Nixon's release of financial statements and tax returns "has made things worse rather than better for him."

Harris said Thursday that 1460 persons polled between January 7 and 10 were asked if they considered it wrong for Mr. Nixon whose income totals \$250,000 a year in salary and expenses, to have ppaid less taxes than someone with an \$8000 annual income.

He said 75 per cent of the respondents called it wrong, 15 per cent disagreed and 10 per cent were unsure.
