Krogh to Enter

Pa. Prison Camp

The Federal Bureau of Prisons has selected its prison camp in Allenwood, Pa., as the place of confinement for Egil Krogh, sentenced to serve six months for his part in the burglary of Dr. Daniel Ellsberg's psychiatrist's office.

A bureau spokesman, Ted Swift, said Krogh's attorneys are working with federal officials on the arrangements for Krogh to enter the prison camp in early February.

Judge Gerhard A. Gesell imposed a two-to-six year sentence on Krogh on Thursday but suspended all but six months to be followed by a period of unsupervised probation.

Krogh, boss of the White House plumbers' unit, had pleaded guilty to a charge of conspiracy to violate the civil rights of the psychiatrist.
