

Proxmire Says Wisconsin

Favors Nixon Resignation

WASHINGTON, Feb. 1 (AP) —Senator William Proxmire, Democrat of Wisconsin, said today a majority of Wisconsin residents responding to a poll favor President Nixon's resignation, but not his impeachment.

A majority are also for the rationing of gasoline, he said. Mr. Proxmire said questionnaires had been sent to 100,000 Wisconsin residents and more than 15,000 had been returned.

Fifty-five per cent of the respondents believed that the President should resign; 43 per cent said he should not, he said.

The impeachment of the President was opposed 53 per cent to 44 per cent, Mr. Proxmire said.

Rationing was favored 53 per cent to 44 per cent and the easing of pollution control standards was favored 69 per cent to 29 per cent.
