One of President Nixon's speechwriters, Lee Huebner, has resigned to join the Whitney Communications Corporation. According to Ronald L. Ziegler, the Presidential press secretary, Mr. Huebner, who has been on the President's staff for five years, is leaving the White House on the "best of terms."

Mr. Ziegler, who volunteered to newsmen the information that Mr. Huebner had been planning to leave for some time, appeared to be addressing himself to reports that some White House staff departures had been prompted by poor morale.
