Judge Sends Nixon

A Travel Voucher

LOS ANGELES, Feb. 5 (UPI)—A California judge sent President Nixon a voucher for \$790.48 today and commanded that Mr. Nixon spend it on travel expenses to testify at the burglary trial of John Ehrlichman and two other former White House officials.

The unprecedented subpoena for "the honorable Richard M. Nixon, President of the United States, a resident of the White House, Washington, D.C.," was signed Monday by Superior Court Judge Gordon Ringer.

The subpoena and expense voucher—round trip coach class air fare from Washington included—were sent by registered mail to the clerk of the Superior Court in Washington.
