## Washington

President Nixon listed four Republicans yesterday as good possibilities to succeed him in the White House in 1976.

They were Vice President Gerald Ford, California Governor Ronald Reagan, former New York Governor Nelson Rockefeller and former Texas Democratic Governor John Connally.

Mr. Nixon also told a breakfast meeting of a group of Republican Congressmen that the political pundits are wrong and the GOP will do better in the November off-year elections than they think.

Mr. Nixon made his remarks at an off-the-record breakfast of about 50 Republicans who belong to the Chowder and Marching Society, a Republican Congressional club. The President is a member of the group and hosted this week's meeting at the White House.
