

Pentagon's Kissinger 'spy' quizzed

WASHINGTON — The chairman of the Senate Armed Services Committee said Navy Yeoman Charles Radford fully answered questions yesterday in a closed interview on allegations of military spying on Henry Kissinger.

Sen. John Stennis (D-Miss.), and staff members interrogated Radford for 2½ hours but would not divulge specifics of the meeting to newsmen.

Radford has acknowledged secretly removing documents from the files of Kissinger and delivering them to the Pentagon.
