

Nixon Visit To Japan Confirmed

The United States and Japan have confirmed President Nixon's intention to visit Japan before the end of this year, Japanese Foreign Minister Masayoshi Ohira said last night.

At a meeting between Ohira and Secretary of State Henry Kissinger last night, the two agreed to start working out suitable dates for the Nixon visit, according to U.S. sources. A U.S. official said the hope is that Hirohito will be able to come to the United States this year.
