

Sets Agnew Hearing

ANNAPOLIS, Md. (AP)—The State Court of Appeals has scheduled an April 2 hearing for oral arguments on recommendations that Spiro T. Agnew be disbarred.

The 10 a.m. hearing will offer Agnew's lawyers another chance to argue that the former vice president be suspended from the bar, rather than disbarred, for his no contest plea in October to an income tax evasion charge.

Agnew appeared before the lower court panel that recommended he be disbarred. It is not known if he will also appear at the Court of Appeals hearing.
