GURNEY ANNOUNCES HE WILL RUN AGAIN

MIAMI, Feb. FEB (AP) 1974 ator Edward J. Gurney, Republican of Florida, said today that he would seek re-election in November and repeated that he was innocent of any wrong-

November and repeated that he was innocent of any wrongdoing in connection with campaign contributions.

The Miami Herald and other Florida newspapers have reported that Larry Williams of Orlando, a former Gurney fundraiser, collected at least \$300,000 in unreported contributions from builders who wanted Mr. Gurney to use influence with the Federal Housing Authority.

Mr. Gurney, the state's senior Senator, said he was seeking re-election to a second term "because I am innocent." There are no other announced Republican candidates.

He spoke in an interview with WCKT-TV taped for broadcast tomorrow.

Asserting that newspaper allegations came mainly from unidentified sources, Mr. Gurney said, "The 'Source' family these days are more prevalent than States."
