SFChronicles 1.3 1974 Senator Scott Would Oppose Firing Jaworski

Senate Republican leader Hugh Scott (Rep-Pa.) said yesterday he will "vote flatly against" firing special Watergate prosecutor Leon Jaworski if it comes up.

Scott told newsmen he hopes such a move is not being given the slightest consideration in the White House, and said he has no reason to believe it is.

Jaworski reported to the Senate Judiciary Committee last week that President Nixon had refused to turn over tapes and documents he had requested in his investigations.

If the issue comes before the Judiciary Committee, of which he is a member, Scott said "I would vote flatly against firing Mr. Jaworski."
