

Nixon Plans Big Trip For Pat

President Nixon is sending his wife, Pat, on a diplomatic-ceremonial mission to Latin America in March to dramatize his personal commitment to "close and cooperative relations" with that area, the White House announced yesterday.

The First Lady will make the 10,000-mile trip March 10-16 to attend the inaugurations of the presidents of Venezuela and Brazil.

Press Secretary Ronald L. Ziegler announced the trip.

Mrs. Nixon will be in Caracas March 11-12 for the inauguration of President Carlos Andres Perez of Venezuela and in Brasilia March 14-15 for the inaugural of President Ernesto Geisel of Brazil.
