month. The President's wife will leave Washington on March 10 and return March 16, her 62d birthday. On March 12 she will attend the inaugura-tion of Carlos Andrés Pérez as President of Venezuela, in Caracas. Then the First Lady will fly to Brasilia for the in-auguration of Gen. Ernesto Geisel on March 15. According to Bonald I

Geisel on March 15. According to Ronald L. Zeigler, the White House press secretary, Mr. Nixon asked his wife to make the trip "as evidence of his per-sonal interest in promoting close and cooperative rela-tions with the nations of South America and the Car-ibbean."

The last time Mrs. Nixon was in Caracas was in 1958, when Mr. Nixon, then Vice President, was the target of stone-throwing rioters.
