Latin Assignment for Mrs. Nixon

Mrs. Richard M. Nixon was named by her husband yesterday to lead the United States delegations to Presidential inaugurations in Venezuela and Brazil next month.

The President's wife will leave Washington on March 10 and return March 16, her 62d birthday. On March 12 she will attend the inauguration of Carlos Andrés Pérez as President of Venezuela, in Caracas. Then the First Lady will fly to Brasilia for the inauguration of Gen. Ernesto Geisel on March 15.

According to Ronald L. Zeigler, the White House press secretary, Mr. Nixon asked his wife to make the trip "as evidence of his personal interest in promoting close and cooperative relations with the nations of South America and the Caribbean."

The last time Mrs. Nixon was in Caracas was in 1958, when Mr. Nixon, then Vice President, was the target of stone-throwing rioters.
