

The State Bar May Discipline Kalmbach

Disciplinary action will be initiated this week against President Nixon's former personal lawyer, Herbert W. Kalmbach Jr., officials of the State Bar said yesterday.

Kalmbach, who has offices in Newport Beach and Los Angeles, pleaded guilty yesterday in Washington to two charges of violating campaign practices laws.

Certified records of Kalmbach's conviction will be obtained from Washington, a State Bar spokesman said, and forwarded to the State Supreme Court for review.

"If we felt this is a case involving moral turpitude, we will ask that he be suspended immediately," the spokesman said.
