## Nixon Erred In Reference To Wiesner

The White House said yes-terday that President Nixon "regrets" having listed Jerome "regrets" having listed Jerome B. Wiesner, president of Mas-sachusetts Institute of Tech-nology, as one of several prominent Americans who have claimed tax deductions for papers contributed to the government.

Wiesner, a former science adviser to President Kennedy, said he never claimed any de-duction at all for donating papers to the National Ar-chives.

Asked how the President ob-tained his information, Deputy Press Secretary Gerald L. Warren said that both United Press International and the Associated Press had reported in December that Wiesner had obtained a tax deduction. When a reporter asked if the President had apologized to Wiesner, Warren said that "of course, the President re-grets mention of Mr. Wies-ner." Asked how the President ob-
