Last Friday, Byck shot himself dead after killing two other persons in an attempt to hijack a jetliner at Baltimore-Washington International Airport. His purpose, Byck

revealed in a tape sent to columnist Jack Anderson, was to crash-dive the plane into the White House.

The reason for his desperate deed, he said on the tapes, was "frustration when you are suddenly aware . . . that this government cannot correct its mistakes, that this government is a government of coverup rather than exposure."
