The Internal Revenue Serv-ice yesterday returned to the Chesapeake & Potomac Tele-phone Co. the company's rec-ords of calls from the home phone of New York Times re-porter David Rosenbaum. A summons for records cov-ering an eight-month period had been issued during an in-vestigation of a suspected leak of tax information. The new-paper charged that the sum-mons was beyond IRS legal authority and an invasion of Rosenbaum's rights. IRS commissioner Donald C. was ordering the records re-turned without agreeing that Alexander told The Times he the summons was improper.
