President Johnson gave the vast bulk of his papers to the government without asking for or getting tax benefits in return, the director of the LBJ Library said yesterday.

Commenting on a report that Johnson's donations had provided up to \$29 million in tax deductions, director Harry J. Middleton said Johnson probably took the then-legal deduction on about 200,000 of the 31 million papers he donated.
