

Dean Burch Is

Sworn In as Cabinet Member

Dean Burch, former chairman of the Federal Communications Commission, was sworn in yesterday as a counselor to President Nixon and as a member of the cabinet.

At an Oval Office ceremony, Mr. Nixon said Burch would handle a general range of assignments, including White House relations with independent agencies of the government such as the FCC.

He also said Burch, a major force in Senator Barry Goldwater's 1964 presidential campaign, would "advise on matters of politics."

Burch, 45, had been FCC chairman since 1969. He was Republican national chairman in 1964-65.
