Poll Finds Nixon Violated Oath

MINNEAPOLIS, March 10 —The latest statewide Minnesota poll published today shows that 58 per cent believe President Nixon has "broken his oath of office." Further a growing number of Minnesotans believe he should be impeached. Sentiment for resignation is also rising, but only 6 per cent think it is likely he will resign.

The poll also shows 73 per cent think Mr. Nixon should yield the additional tapes and documents requested by the Watergate special prosecutor.

The poll by the Minneapolis Tribune of 605 persons two weeks ago found 47 per cent favoring resignation. A similar November poll found 36 per cent. Likewise, 47 per cent now want Mr. Nixon impeached, compared to 35 per cent in the November poll. Of those favoring resignation, 77 per cent said impeachment proceedings should be started.
