Martha Mitchell blamed the White House yesterday for the problems faced by her and her estranged husband, former Attorney General John N. Mitchell.

Mrs. Mitchell denied that she is an alcoholic and said she has "come to the conclusion that Mitchell was framed."

At her own request, she was interviewed by Barbara Walters on the NBC-TV program "Today."

Mrs. Mitchell alleged that important persons in the Nixon Administration sought to get rid of her because she was a nuisance. Their tactic in such cases, she said, is to give a person a reputation of being crazy or alcoholic.

Asked whether President Nixon ought to be impeached she paused and said, "I don't know."
