

Surprises -- From Politics to Parties

House Majority Leader Tyomas (Tip) O'Neill of Massacyusetts apparently thinks Richard Nixon will be out of office soon.

O'Neill, in a talk he thought was off the record, told Harvard Institute of Politics students that special prosecutor Leon Jaworski had evidence which could lead to indictment of the President.

A Nixon resignation, O'Neill reportedly said, would come in April or May. O'Neill's aides, furious at the leak, labeled the students' report "misinformation," but O'Neill did not deny it.
