A. B. C. - TV Cancels Mrs. Nixon

The American Broadcasting Company has canceled the guest appearance of Mrs. Richard M. Nixon on tomorrow's "Issues and Answers" television interview, because of a dispute with the White House over ground rules for her appearance. The White House had originally agreed to a format for the program that included a few minutes of film from Mrs. Nixon's Latin American trip, followed by questions from a panel of newsmen.

But late this week Ronald L. Ziegler, White House press secretary, called A.B.C. and said that Mrs. Nixon would be available for only 10 minutes of questions.

"They wanted to change the ground rules on us," said John Lynch, chief of the network's Washington bureau. "We said no." Tomorrow's "Issues and Answers" guest will be Abba Eban, Foreign Minister of Israel.
