Sirica's Action Halts Waldie Walk

Congressman Jerome R. Waldie (Dem-Antioch) will cut short his campaign walk today to meet with his colleagues on the House Judiciary Committee on the latest developments in the impeachment probe of President Nixon, his office announced yesterday.

Waldie, a candidate for the Democratic gubernatorial nomination, was making a walk from Sacramento to San Francisco when he received word in Vallejo that Judge John Sirica had ruled a grand jury report concerning Mr. Nixon's involvement, if any, in the Watergate should be transmitted to the Judiclary Committee.

That ruling, Waldie said, "in effect completes the indictment that was handed down March 1 (against seven former White House and Committee to Re-elect the President aides.").

He added that "with this report which represents the grand jury's conclusion as to presidential involvement before us, I expect the committee's impeachment inquiry will be able to move more quickly toward a final decision."
