Jill Ruckelshaus, wife of former deputy attorney general William D. Ruckelshaus, has resigned as special assistant to presidential counsellor Anne Armstrong.

Mrs. Ruckelshaus told reporters Monday she was resigning because of the demands of her family of five young children.

She said she had been able to work only three days a week recently and was finding it increasingly difficult to give even this much time to her job as head of the White House office of women's programs.

Her husband was fired and Attorney General Elliot Richardson resigned from their Justice Department posts rather than follow President Nixon's orders to dismiss Special Watergate Prosecutor Archibald Cox.
