2 IN MILLS CAMPAIGN QUERIED ON FUNDS

LITTLE ROCK, Ark., March 18 (UPI) — Two officials of the Draft Mills for President Committee have been questioned by the special Watergate prosecutor's staff and the Senate Watergate committee staff about possible illegal contributions to the Mills organization.

The officials were asked about contributions from the Associated Milk Producers, Inc.

The officials are Charles Ward of Conway, Ark., who was chairman of the committee backing Representative Wilbur D. Mills, and George Jernigan of Little Rock, the treasurer. "I know nothing about that. I had no part of it," Representative Mills, Democrat of Arkansas, said yesterday.
