No More Bad Conduct Code **On Vets' Papers**

Washington

Yielding to Congressional pressure the Defense De-partment announced yesterday it no longer will code veterans' papers so employ-ers can determine the reason for discharge.

Representative E d w a r d Hebert (Dem-La.) who fought for years against the policy, said the change would end discrimination against veterans discharged for relatively minor reasons, such as unsuitability for military life and attitude problems.

Hebert said many employ-ers, know the code and use the information to deny jobs to ex-soldiers who may have been honorably discharged. .
