## No More Bad Conduct Code On Vets' Papers

Washington

Yielding to Congressional pressure the Defense Department announced yesterday it no longer will code veterans' papers so employers can determine the reason for discharge.

Representative Edward Hebert (Dem-La.) who fought for years against the policy, said the change would end discrimination against veterans discharged for relatively minor reasons, such as unsuitability for military life and attitude problems.

Hebert said many employers know the code and use the information to deny jobs to ex-soldiers who may have been honorably discharged.
