Buckley Opposed 4 to 1 on Nixon Plea

Aides of Sen. James L. Buckley (Cons.-R.-N.Y.) say that telegrams and phone calls are running about 4 to 1 against his call for President Nixon's resignation.

Many phone calls received in the senator's New York office are "extremely abusive," and the telegrams feature such words as "traitor" and "nut," they said. ^{20 MAR}

By mid-afternoon Wednesday, nearly 30 hours after he called for Mr. Nixon's resignation, they said Buckley had received about 1,000 telegrams and phone calls.
