Ehrlichman Trial Scheduled To Begin April 15 on Coast

To Begin April 15 on Coast LOS ANGELES, March 26 (UPI)—The trial of John D. Ehrlichman, former White House adviser on domestic af-fairs, on perjury charges is scheduled to begin April 15. That would make Mr. Ehrlich-man the first former high White House official to face a jury for the Ellsberg burglary. Mr. Ehrlichman is the only one of the four original de-fendants who still faces trial in a California court. He is charged with lying to a county grand jury when he testified that he did not know in advance that the White House "plumbers" planned to rifle the files of Daniel Ellsberg's former psychiatrist. The trial date was set yester-day in a conference involving the prosecutor, Stephen Trott; a defense attorney, Douglas Dal-ton, and Superior Court Judge Gordon Ringer.
