

A New Home

In Maryland SFChronicle Annapolis, Md.

Former Vice President Spiro T. Agnew has bought a home in an exclusive development three miles from the Maryland capitol where he once lived as governor, a representative of the builder said yesterday.

"The Agnews bought the house on Saturday," said Amalita McGowan, wife and secretary of builder Charles McGowan. "But I'm not to give out any more information because Mr. Agnew plans to make a formal announcement."

The two - story, red brick home in the Indian Hills area is still under construction.

Agnew sold his suburban Washington home last week for \$300,000 at a reported profit of \$110,000. Mrs. McGowan said the new home cost "between \$70,000 and \$175,000."
