

To Probe Nixon Taxes

SACRAMENTO, April 2 — Hearings were ordered today in the California Legislature into President Nixon's tax liability in the state, where the Nixons in 1969 bought their San Clemente estate.

The hearings were ordered by California Assembly Speaker Bob Moretti, who declared: "He owes the state some money. There is no doubt in my mind on that." He assigned the task to the Revenue and Taxation Committee, headed by Assemblyman Joe A. Golzales, a Democrat from Los Angeles.
