

**Report on Nixon Taxes  
Available to the Public**

WASHINGTON, April 3—  
The report on President Nixon's income taxes, released today by the Congressional Joint Committee on Internal Revenue Taxation, will be put on sale by the main Government Printing Office bookstore here by Friday morning, a spokesman for the office said today.

The 1,008 - page report, titled "Examination of President Nixon's Tax Returns for 1969 Through 1972," will cost \$6.50. It can be ordered by writing to the Public Documents Department, Government Printing Office, Washington, D.C. 20402. A check or money order must be enclosed, payable to the Superintendent of Documents.

Jay Young, chief of sales planning for the G.P.O., said that 5,000 copies of the document, officially known as Senate report 768, would be printed for public sale. He added that the agency would "reprint quickly, if necessary."
