Texans offer to buy Nixon Veep papers

DALLAS — Two Texas-based groups who support President Nixon offered yesterday to buy his vice presidential papers for \$500,000 to get him out of his tax jam.

Otis Davenport, a Dallas real estate broker, said the groups made the offer through the Washington office of George Bush, national Republican chairman.

Davenport said the offer to buy the vice presidential papers for half a million dollars came from groups called citizens appeal for reason and the national committee to support the presidency.

"If we are successful, the papers would be donated to Baylor University," said Davenport, who has served on both organizations. "They would also be used by other schools and libraries but Baylor would be their home base."

Davenport is a member of the Baylor Development Board.
