Columnist Terms Connally Target of Bribery Inquiry

John B. Connally, former Treasury Secretary, is under investigation by Watergate prosecutors for bribery, Jack Anderson, the columnist, said today.

prosecutors for bribery. Jack Anderson, the columnist, said today. Mr. Connally, considered a contender for the 1976 Repub-lican Presidential nomination, denied the allegation. Investigators from the Fed-eral Bureau of Investigation as-signed to the special prosecu-tion have evidence that Mr. Connally pocketed \$10,000 from the Associated Milk Pro-ducers, Inc., the columnist said. Mr. Anderson quoted F.B.I. sources as saying the alleged \$10,000 bribe was passed by an official of the producers group, Robert Lilly, to Jake Jacobsen, a lobbyist, who delivered it to Mr. Jacobsen is under indict-ment for perjury for testifying that he put the \$10,000 in a safe deposit box and never re-moved it until the F.B.I. opened the box last November. A Connally associate has said that Mr. Jacobsen offered the \$10,000 as a campaign contri-bution for distribution to G.O.P. condidates but that Mr. Con-nally turned down the offer.
