Poll Gives an Edge To Impeachment

The Harris Survey said yesterday that "by 43 to 41 per cent, a narrow plurality of the American people is now prepared to agree that President Nixon should be impeached by Congress and removed from office, while 16 per cent are unsure."

The poll, conducted by Louis Harris and Associates, Inc., is the first to record a popular margin in favor of Congress removing Mr. Nixon from the presidency, Harris said.

The results came from a national cross section of 1495 households interviewed between March 24 and 29, and "it is fair to conclude that the American people now want the full procedures of the Constitution regarding impeachment to be invoked against President Nixon." Harris said.
