

Nixon Spending Easter Weekend In Key Biscayne

President Nixon flew to Florida yesterday to spend the Easter weekend with his family at their Key Biscayne home.

Mrs. Nixon, daughter Patricia and son-in-law Edward Cox joined the President along with White House Chief of Staff Alexander M. Haig Jr. and Press Secretary Ronald L. Ziegler.

Earlier yesterday the President named Foy D. Kohler, former Ambassador to Moscow, as a member of the Board for International Broadcasting which helps Congress keep tabs on operations of Radio Free Europe and Radio Liberty.

Mr. Nixon also appointed Leonard Garment, one of his assistants, as vice chairman of the Council of the Administrative Conference of the United States. The group was set up to improve legal procedures of government agencies.
