William D. Ruckelshaus, former dsputy U.S. attorney general, has been hired by the Florida Apartment Association to fight rising electric bills, it was announced yesterday.

Association President James Mahaffey said Ruckelshaus would visit Tallahas-

Ruckelshaus quit as deputy attorney general rather than follow President Nixon's order to fire former Watergate special prosecutor Archibald Cox.
