**Nixon Appoints Garment  
To Legal Study Panel**

WASHINGTON, April 12— President Nixon announced today the appointment of Leonard Garment, assistant to the President, as one of the 10 members of the Council of the Administrative Conference of the United States for a three year term.

Mr. Garment succeeds Edward L. Morgan, who left to become an Assistant Secretary of the Treasury, in the unpaid position of both member and vice chairman of the council.

The conference, which has a staff of 15 and an annual budget of approximately \$600,000, is intended to develop improvements in the legal procedures of the United States in administering regulatory, benefit and other Government programs.
