President Nixon need not worry about getting a "warm and hearty" reception when he delivers the keynote address at the 83d continental congress of the Daughters of the American Revolution this morning, Mrs. Donald Spicer, the retiring president-general of the D.A.R., promised yesterday. The 197,000 member organization supports Mr. Nixon all the way, said Mrs. Spicer in Washing-

ton, and the D.A.R. further believes the President has been "misunderstood and victimized by Congress and the press." The organization's debate and voting on various resolutions yesterday was closed to reporters, Mrs. Spicer said, because delegates feared being "misquoted by outsiders."
