

# DAR Wanders the White House

President Nixon gave members of the Daughters of the American Revolution virtually free run of the White House yesterday afternoon and more than 3000 of them accepted his extraordinary invitation to wander about from the First Family's living quarters

right into the oval office.

White House officials said Mr. Nixon had granted such privileges only once before to a group of visitors—last May 24, when he hosted a dinner for the newly returned Vietnam prisoners of war and their families.

Mr. Nixon, who invited the
