**Romney Asserts Staff
Cleared Acts With Nixon**

RICHMOND, April 22 (UPI)
—George Romney said today that President Nixon must have known what his 1972 re-election staff was doing at the time of the Watergate break-in.

Mr. Romney, former Secretary of Housing and Urban Development under Mr. Nixon, said staff and campaign workers cleared all actions with the President. Mr. Romney, now president of the National Center for Voluntary Action, said, "I don't think they did anything without his approval."
