Nixon's Potential Witnesses
For Hearing on Tax Lawyer

SACRAMENTO, Calif., April 22 (UPI)—Secretary of State Edmund G. Brown Jr. has issued a list of potential witnesses, headed by President Nixon and his wife, for a June 17 hearing into charges against a Nixon tax attorney.

The hearing is the next step in Mr. Brown's attempt to revoke the notary public commission of the Los Angeles attorney, Frank DeMarco Jr., for alleged illegal backdating of a deed to Mr. Nixon's Vice-Presidential papers. Mr. Nixon used them for a \$576,000 tax deduction.

Mr. Brown noted: "Mr. DeMarco has requested this list to determine who might have first-hand knowledge concerning the case." Also on the list are two members of Mr. Brown's staff who took part in the investigation.
