

Draws Praise From Reagan

Sacramento

Governor Ronald Reagan said yesterday it would be "really stretching" to assert now that President Nixon doesn't want to provide all pertinent White House evidence on Watergate.

Reagan said the action of the President in turning over edited transcripts of taped presidential conversations "should restore some confidence" in Nixon.

During a question and answer session with high school seniors, Reagan said Nixon "has gone farther than any President in history with regard to making presidential private documents available not only to the Legislature but to the public."
